

448 – Tamara

Gauge Swatch (US6) – finished measurement 5.25” wide by 4” high

Cast on 30 stitches

Row 1: [K2, (p1, k1) 3x, k2] 3x
Row 2: [p4, (k2, p1) twice, p2] 3x
Row 3: [K2, (p1, k1) 3x, k2] 3x
Row 4: [p4, (k2, p1) twice, p2] 3x
Row 5: [K2, (p1, k1) 3x, k2] 3x
Row 6: [p4, (k2, p1) twice, p2] 3x
Row 7: [K2, (p1, k1) 3x, k2] 3x
Row 8: [k1, p1, k1, p5, k1, p1] 3x
Row 9: [p1, k6, p1, k1] 3x
Row 10: [k1, p1, k1, p5, k1, p1] 3x
Row 11: [p1, k6, p1, k1] 3x
Row 12: [k1, p1, k1, p5, k1, p1] 3x
Row 13: [p1, k6, p1, k1] 3x
Row 14: [k1, p1, k1, p5, k1, p1] 3x

Repeat rows 1-14 one time, then repeat rows 1-8 one time – total 36 rows

Once gauge has been achieved, work hem area for all pieces (back, both fronts, both sleeves).

- Cast on with smaller needles (US3) for size selected using color B
- Work 1 ¼ inches in stockinette stitch (we felt that moss stitch was too bulky) from cast on edge ending with purl side facing
- Knit one row (on wrong side) to form a fold line
