

*461 - Argyle Fair Isle Sock

Prework: Cast on and complete cuff ribbing as indicated in pattern.

A note on sizing: Keep in mind that Fair Isle knitting has very little stretch. So, if you have feet that measure longer than the sizes indicated on the pattern, have a deep instep, or prefer the "leg part" of your sock to fit a little loosely, you may want to consider casting on 80 stitches and working with a US3 needle.

Jenna's sock was knit on 80 stitches using a US3 needle to accommodate her 10" long foot and 9.5" diameter ankles. It is a tiny bit snug when she pulls it up over her heel, but it fits her leg comfortably.
