

## \*464 - Reseda Jacket

- Pre-soften yarn if desired. Using white or ecru cotton yarn, tie the hank in 6" segments (to minimize tangling). Soak the hank in boiling water for at least 15 minutes. Drain the hot water and replace with ice water. Soak until the yarn hank is COLD. Repeat the hot/cold sequence one more time. Wring the hank to remove excess water - roll in a towel. Toss the hank into the dryer on hot (cotton) for 30 minutes or until thoroughly dry. Note: If softening more than one hank at a time, make sure to place each hank into a zippered pillow case to prevent them from tangling together. Once dry, you will need to hand wind the hank into a ball.
- Work a gauge swatch 22 sts x 28 rows in stockinette:
  - Cast on 26 stitches
  - Knit 3 rows
  - \*K2, P22, K2
  - Knit
  - Repeat from \* 13 more times - total of 28 rows of stockinette.
  - Knit 3 rows, bind off.

If you are using pre-softened yarn, measure the 22sts x 28rows for 4" x 4"

If you did NOT pre-soften the yarn you will need to wash and dry your swatch prior to measuring.
